

# **Studley Entaco Green Report December 2021 / January 2022**

## **Tue 30 Nov**

Tallis Amos called about the mower, much work needed with a cost of £2329.35  
Committee meeting in the afternoon where it was agreed to go ahead with the work to the Dennis Razor mower.  
Emailed Tallis Amos confirming the order.

## **Wed 1 Dec**

Cut the green with the old mower height of cut 8mm.  
Applied E2Pro Instant to the green with the sprayer.

## **Tue 14 Dec**

Looked over the green. Used whip to disperse worm casts.

## **Tue 21 Dec**

Cleared worm casts off the green.  
Went over the green with the aerator using the slit tines.  
Spread granular feed over the green.

*Lot of cold and frosty weather during much of January unable to get on green for a considerable time.*

## **Fri 14 Jan**

Call from Tallis Amos to say they were returning the mower, mower returned looked good nice and clean, started up first pull.  
Carried out a stock take of green maintenance products.  
Very cold green covered in frost and the outside tap was frozen.

## **Wed 26 Jan**

Got on to green at last, went over the green with the light brush.  
Reset the mower height of cut to 8mm and cut the green took off five barrows of cuttings.  
Mower working very well lovely cut had to raise the height of the groomer (*set to low dragging on the green*) Operation of the mower a bit tight to start with but did loosen up after some use.  
After cutting the green went over with the aerator using the slit tines.

Had received an order from Agrovista detailing the recommended products for the green maintenance for the coming season. The recommendations were the results of the soil samples taken last November. Went through the items and deducted those which we already had in stock.

## **Fri 28 Jan**

Met John Mullins on site to look over the green, found small areas of moss and agreed to add four bags of Lawn Sand to the order to combat the moss.  
Latter in the day received an updated order with the price adjustments.  
Have not yet received the monthly plan of work, but when I do I will split the order in to two a spring delivery and a summer delivery which will, help with the limited storage space for these materials. The cost can also be spread over the two deliveries.  
John Mullins explained there were long delivery times.
