

Studley Entaco Green Report

January / February 2020

Tue 28 Jan

Replaced mower cylinder in the old mower ready for tomorrow
Started cutting the green approx one third before running out of time.

Wed 29 Jan

Arranged to scarify the green with help from Ian and Bill however the green was frosted over had to put it off till the afternoon. Finished cutting the green with Ian's help and then scarified and then went over with the mower to collect the debris from the scarifier, but ran out of time before completing.

Thu 30 Jan

Went over the green again with the mower collecting up debris left by the scarifier. Hand raked some of the dead moss still in the green, still more to do.

Wed 5 Feb

Went over the green with the slit tine aerator.
Carried out some minor repairs on the green.
Started off first brew of compost tea.

Thu 6 Feb

Applied first brew of compost tea, had to put back this spraying till the afternoon green very frosty.
Started off second batch.
Met John Mullins at the green to discuss the products recommended for the coming season.

Fri 7 Feb

Sprayed second brew of compost tea.

Mon 10 Feb

Started off the third brew of compost tea.

Tue 11 Feb

Sprayed green with third brew of compost tea. Cleaned all the equipment and the sprayer.
Had problems with the sprayer turned out there was air getting in at the main filter, reseated the rubber seal and tightened up the fitting all o.k now.

Have inspected the green at least twice a week to make sure all is in order.
Need to cut the green also need to aerate with the slit tines. However the weather has been so wet unable to get on the green with out causing possible damage.

Looking from the club house, on the left hand corner of the green the green ditch has water practically up to the level of the grass. Do we need to investigate the drainage from this corner.
