### Wed 2<sup>nd</sup>

### Fri 18<sup>th</sup>

Persistent rain during the morning, unable to cut the green, Arranged with Mike V and Neal D to cut the following day (Saturday morning)

Neal D cut the green with Mike V assisting with the groomer engaged, Mike also strimmed the edges of the green and some of the long grass, weeds and thistles on the outside of the fence.

### Fri 25<sup>th</sup>

Treated the green with “Aquasorb” and “Manifol Excel”, after spraying used the watering system to help wash the treatment in with just one pass of the watering sprayers to each side of the green.

*Aquasorb is quite gloopy and can leave the green somewhat sticky which can also make bowls sticky if it is not washed in.*
