

Studley Entaco Green Report May 2022

Mon 2nd

Green not cut.

Wed 4th

Green not cut, Heavey rain

Fri 6th

Cut the green with M.V assistance.

Came to spray the green but the sprayer would not work, phoned Dave Johnson (electrition) who agreed to come and look at it next week.

Mon 9th

Green not cut P.H ill with Covid, could not get there myself because of family issues.

Dave Johnson phoned to say he could come to look at the sprayer tomorrow.

Tue10th

Dave came out to look at the sprayer and after examining and testing discovered the battery had died. Ordered a replacement battery from Moredale, should arrive next day.

Turned on the irrigation system.

Wed 11th

Collected the battery from Moredale and put it on the sprayer, sprayer now working o.k.

Green not cut, rain.

Thu 12th

Cut the green and then sprayed with Intrench and GoGreen plus as the schedule.

Fri 13th

Changed the cassette in the old mower to the sorrel roller and then went over the green with the sorrel roller.

Sprayed the green with Aquasorb and Fossil.

Fri 20th

M.V unable to assist, medical issues.

Changed the cassette in the old mower to the verticutter, set the height, went over the green with the verticutter and then followed with the main mower height of cut 4.5 mm. On the extreme edges of the green raised the height of cut to 6.5 mm, 300mm in from the edge changed the height of cut to 5.5mm then reset the height of cut to 4.5mm on completion.

Fri 27th

Cut the green with M.V assistance, engaged the groomer, took of 6 barrows of cuttings.

Now that the season is well underway and things have settled down somewhat the green is being cut on Mondays by Peter Holtom and Dave ??, on Wednesdays by Bill McNeish and Robert Uzzell and on Fridays myself and Mike Varnam.
